



<u>Gullah Geechee Environment & Energy Roundtables –</u> Small focus groups of 12 - 15 persons hosted by the Gullah Geechee Chamber Foundation throughout our community to determine the levels of knowledge and the work being done in regarding the impact of climate change, career and business opportunities in green, renewable energy, and environmental justice.

<u>Gullah Geechee Environment & Energy Conversations –</u> Monthly conversations between environment/energy organizations and the Gullah community to "be a resource to each other" through the exchange of ideas, missions and to advocate with and for the community.

<u>The Gullah Geechee Environment & Energy Conference</u> an annual Conference hosting Environment, Energy and Cultural speakers and panels with a focus on sharing knowledge regarding the impact of Climate Change, career and business opportunities in green, renewable energy, electric vehicles and the training of activists to advocate for the community and its role in the future of solar, wind, green hydrogen and other energy sources
