









How much of your EE workforce (directly employed or indirectly contracted) has been affected by reduced hours or job losses?











Southeast Clean Energy & Energy Efficiency Workforce

% Clean Energy & Energy Efficiency Cumulative Job Losses by State























Quarterly New Vehicle Sales






